In the modernization of electrical service.

The inefficiency and excessive or unjustified operation costs of providing the service should be a thing of the past. President Felipe Calderon instructed the Director of the CFE Alfredo Elias Ayub to modernize the Electrical Power System in the Valley of Mexico.

“ ... A complete reengineering has taken place to modernize the billing and collection process, which was plagued with discrepancies and omissions. We are close to the target of billing the total consumption based on actual readings. We have begun the substitution, at no cost for the user, of the electromechanical meter for more modern electronic meters.



These new meters are more accurate, far more simple and above all, allow the user to read his own consumption and avoid billing doubts; to date, 300,000 users have benefitted from the 234,000 electronic meters installed in the Valley of Mexico, and by the end of the year, subject to agreement with the SUTERM (Mexican Electrician Workers Union), a much larger number of these will be installed ...” FCH
